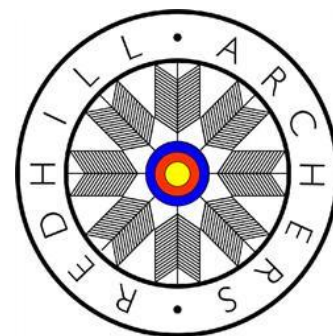

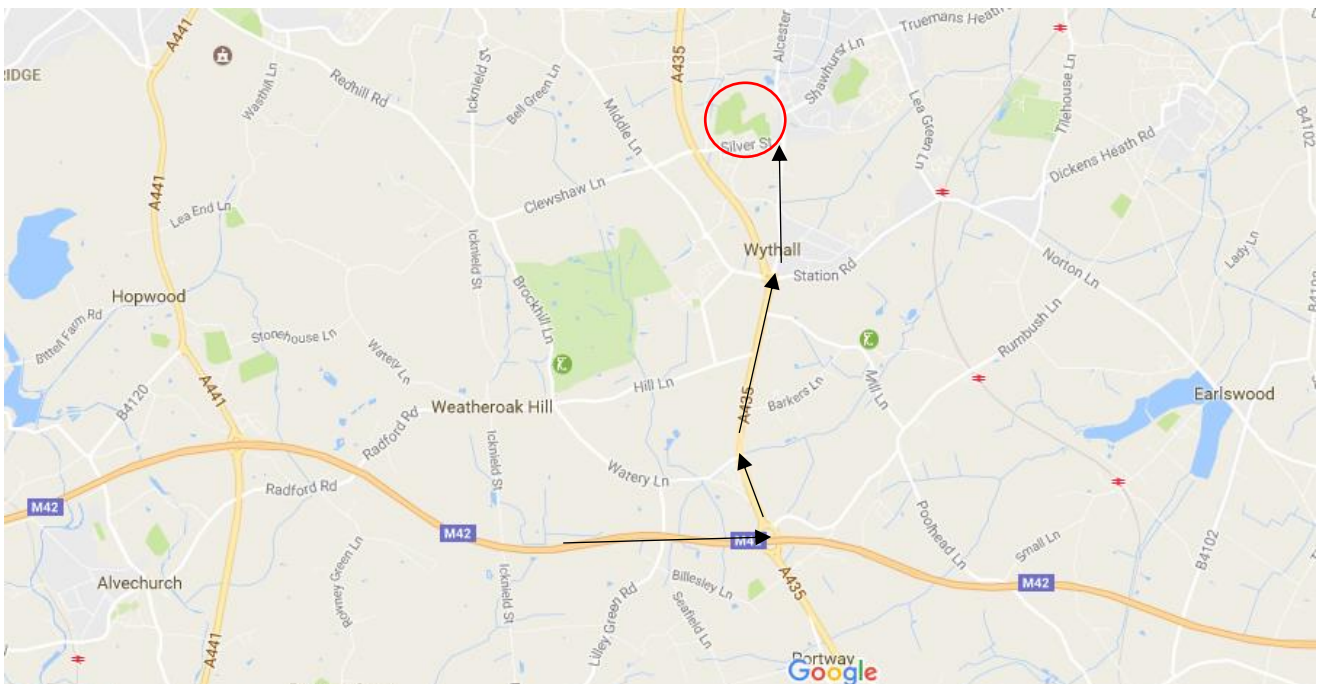

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Brief directions to the range:



Leave the M42 at Junction 3

Take the exit signposted A435 Birmingham

At the next roundabout (Becketts), take the 3rd exit onto the Alcester Road

Stay on the Alcester Road, take the 2nd exit (Silver Street) at the crossroads

Take the 1st exit on the right to Wythall Park

Please note that for morning session archers, a parking pass will be available to collect from the range that will need to be placed in your car to cover car parking charges. For afternoon archers, car parking charges will not apply after 12 noon. Any afternoon session archers that arrive before 12 noon will be asked to pay a minimal car parking charge (payable by cash, card or phone app).
